

Rothbury Village Council Meeting

April 20, 2021

The regularly scheduled meeting of the council was opened at 7:00 PM in the Village Hall by President Scott Beishuizen.

Council members present were Cindy Cruz, Autumn Drake, Jim Fekken, Mike Harris and Brandy Williams. Absent: Vern Talmadge

Also present: Treasurer Deb Murphy, Police Chief Tom Hasper, Sgt. Ethan Walker, Barb Thompson, Cliff Cudney and Harold Drake

After the pledge of allegiance, the minutes were approved as presented.

Chief Hasper gave the monthly report which included an update on blight issues.

Deb Murphy gave the treasurer's report for March 2021 which is the end of the fiscal year.

Harris made a motion, seconded by Cruz to allow the Clerk and Treasurer to move forward with the purchase of computers for the council. Motion carried, 6 ayes, 0 nays.

Due to the absence of Nancy Rolf President Beishuizen gave the report on the Easter Egg Hunt. 60-70 children attended the event.

A new custodian has been hired at the Community Center. Canderlario Frausto lives near the RCC and is being paid by the hour until the Center has normal rentals.

Motion made by Harris, seconded by Fekken to pay the bills. Motion carried, 6 ayes, 0 nays.

Motion made by Cruz, seconded by Harris to pay the MML Liability Insurance premium of \$11,409.00. Motion carried, 6 ayes, 0 nays.

President Beishuizen discussed the well drilling bid he had obtained from Raymer Water Supply Contractors. The current well at the Village Hall has unacceptable levels of PFAS.

Brandy Williams informed the council of an upcoming vaccination clinic at the Back Forty Ranch.

Drake made a motion, seconded by Harris to pass a resolution to opt into the Oceana County Brownfield Redevelopment Authority. Motion carried, 6 ayes, 0 nays. Full resolution follows. Full resolution was filed in the Oceana County Clerk's office April 28, 2021-Clerk.

Meeting stood adjourned at 7:36 PM.
